The Turning Point in the Law of Slavery and Freedom in Massachusetts EMILY BLANCK IN 1783, the Supreme Judicial Court of Massachusetts pronounced Quock Walker-and all other slaves in the com-monwealth-free In that stroke, the court transformed Massa-chusetts from the first colony to legalize slavery into the first state immediately to deny its citizenry the right to hold human property
