### **Social Skills: Measurable IEP Goals**

Social Skills: Measurable IEP Goals 1 During unstructured play times, \_\_\_\_ will interact with peers in an appropriate manner through maintaining personal space and a respectful voice for an average 80% of intervals, measured over a 2 week period 2 \_\_\_\_ will decrease inappropriate verbal comments (such as "you are weird" or "you are a loser") to 1 time per week or less by responding

### **Social Interdependence Theory by Johnson & Johnson**

Social interdependence exists when the accomplishment of each individual's goals is affected by the actions of others (Deutsch, 1949, 1962; Johnson, 1970; D W Johnson & RJohnson, 1989) There are two types of social interdependence, positive (cooperation) and negative (competition) • Positive interdependence exists when individuals perceive that they can reach their goals if and only
