rapid automatized naming (RAN) task to measure the general processing speed component, where children were asked to name printed digits (2, 4, 6, 7, and 9, each repeated 10 times) as fast and accurately as possible Experiment 1 found a strong relationship between writing and reading ability, whereas the role of phonological awareness was minor

text keeps you focused and builds reading speed 4 Survey your text before you start your reading Look at the surrounding information For example, if you need to read one particular chapter of a book, make sure you skim-read (see below for skim reading) the introduction to the book The introduction will give you an account of the concepts

Word Reading (Ages 6-17+) Measures speed and accuracy of decontextualised word recognition The student reads aloud from a list of words that increase in difficulty The list of words is read without a time limit The examiner records the student's progress after 30 seconds and continues administration until the discontinue rule is met or the last item is administered ...

Cognitive Processes and Reading •Rapid automatic naming measures, similar to Naming Speed Literacy, significantly predict reading ability in both younger and older children with reading disorder (Park & Lombardino, 2013) •Children with reading disorders perform poorly on verbal learning measures (Kibby & Cohen, 2008)

Rapid Automatised Naming Students who have a weakness in one or more of these areas are more likely to experience literacy-learning difficulties Phonological and Phonemic Awareness Many students with learning difficulties have difficulty attending to the sounds and oral language patterns within words This ability is called phonological awareness In the early years of ...
